Whether you currently use Quick Books or are just considering it for your business needs, this series of workshops is for you. On October 27, November 3<sup>rd</sup>, and November 11<sup>th</sup>, the Community Development Partnership and SCORE will be hosting a three-part workshop series on QuickBooks for Desktop. All sessions will take place remotely via Zoom, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and will be taught by SCORE mentor Megan Terrio, CPA.

The first two sessions, held on October 27<sup>th</sup> and November 3<sup>rd</sup>, will serve as an "Introduction to QuickBooks." The classes are geared towards business owners who are planning to use QuickBooks, have recently started or are looking for a refresher of the basics.
